Synopsis : Denton Police arrested Cory Crockett, 20 of Camden Wyoming DE, and Tessa Everngam, 18 of Easton MD, for controlled dangerous substance violations. Police were called to the Goose Creek in reference to a possible underage possession of alcohol violation. On arrival the vehicle was leaving the lot and observed the vehicle turn east on Shore Highway without using a turn signal. The vehicle was stopped and officers immediately noted a strong odor of marihuana. The driver was identified as Everngam and passenger as Crockett. A subsequent probable cause search resulted in the seizure of suspected marihuana, cocaine and heroin, all in sufficient quantity or packaging to indicate it was for distribution. Both suspects were arrested and charged with possession with intent to distribute CDS - marihuana, possession with intent to distribute - not marihuana and possession of CDS paraphernalia. Both were taken before a District Court Commissioner who ordered both suspects released on their own recognizance after an initial appearance hearing.

Synopsis : Denton Police are investigating a burglary. Synopsis : Denton Police charged Bryan Hickman, 25 of Greensboro, and Kyle Miller, 22 of Denton, with possession of controlled dangerous substance paraphernalia. Police were investigating a suspicious vehicle complaint and observed a syringe, which appeared to contain suspected heroin residue, under the vehicle. It appeared that the syringe had been placed there recently due to weather conditions. Hickman admitted the syringe was his. A search of the vehicle led to the seizure of a spoon and a cotton ball that also contained suspected heroin residue beneath the seat where Miller had been seated. Both suspects were issued criminal citations for possession of CDS paraphernalia and released on their signature of the citations.

Synopsis : Denton Police charged James Little, 25 of Denton, with possession of controlled dangerous substance (CDS) paraphernalia. Officers observed the vehicle a short distance away from the scene and stopped it. During the course of the investigation King gave consent to search the vehicle because she believed there was CDS and/or CDS paraphernalia in the vehicle. The search resulted in the seizure of a syringe that contained suspected heroin residue. Little was issued a criminal citation at the scene, charging him with possession of CDS paraphernalia and released on his signature of that citation.

**Synopsis :** *The Denton Police Department arrested Daryl Thomas Green, 21 of Denton, for armed robbery and related charges. On January 26, 2014, at approximately 0340 hours, Officers responded to the 7-11 on N. 6th Street in reference to an armed robbery. The store clerk advised that a black male had entered the store, brandished a handgun and demanded money. The clerk complied and the suspect then fled on foot with approximately \$130.00 in small bills. While responding to the scene officers checked the immediate area but did not observe anyone on foot. Officers checked the outside of the store and located fresh footprints in the snow. Officers followed the trail to an apartment at Village Circle and made contact with the occupants of the apartment, one of which was Green. The occupants were advised why the officers were there. Officers secured the residence and made application for a search and seizure warrant which was granted. During the execution of the search and seizure warrant evidence was located, and seized, related to this incident in Green's bedroom. The firearm that was supposedly used was recovered outside Green's bedroom window. Green was placed under arrest and charged with armed robbery, robbery, use of a firearm during a crime of violence, theft under \$1000, first degree assault, second degree assault and reckless endangerment. Green was taken before a District Court Commissioner who ordered Green held in lieu of \$500,000 bail.*
